AYRES Lt Col Brian William Ayres MBE died 26 May 2019

BEALE Lt Col Karl Saxon Beale MC 12 May 1929 - 12 April 2019 SAS. 1 Bn Q Own Royal West Kent Regt Malaya, MiD, 3 Para Suez, 44 Para Oman later Sultan of Oman i/c special forces

BLOCK Peter Block Legion d'Honneur 22 June 1932 - 15 January 2019 Volunteer parachutist and interpreter Op Hasty - Italy, Op Dragoon South of France August 1944, Greece

BOLT Alan Bolt 1919-2019 Royal Marines, King's Royal Rifle Corps. North Africa, captured, sent to Italy then Stalag IV-B

BUDD Col David John Budd MBE RA died 16 June 2019 aged 89

CLARKE Air Cdre Charles Clark OBE 25 November 1923 - 7 May 2019 Bomb aimer 619 Sqn Woodall Spa shot down over Black Forest 1944 Stalag Luft III watcher, forger. Long March to Lubeck Later CO RAF Stafford, Palestine, Aden, Malta

CLEVELAND-STEVENSON Captain Robert (Bobby) Cleveland-Stevens Legion d'Honneur 12 July 1919 - 6 March 2019

Welsh Guards (relinquished pacifism when it failed to prevent war) Op Goodwood. First tank to enter Brussels after fastest fighting armoured thrust in history (97 miles 14 hour) Wounded in Germany

COHEN Lt Col Mordaunt Cohen MBE TD DL 16 August 1916 - 18 April 2019 1940 joined TA anti aircraft artillery. 1942 Nigeria later i/c Muslim soldiers fighting Japanese in Burma. Rejoined TA in 1954. Assn of Jewish ex Servicemen

DARWALL Freddie Darwall died 12 March 2019 aged 89 Royal Marines

ENGEL Charles Engel 1921-2019 Jewish refugee 1936. Wartime service Queen's Own Royal West Kent Regt Battle of Anzio Jan 1944 Later academic

EVERETT Cdr Peter Joscelyn Everett OBE RN died 24 March 2019 aged 92

EYRE (later Sir) Sub Lt Reginald Edwin Eyre RNVR 28 May 1924 - 26 January 2019

FARR (Sir) Charles Blandford Farr CMG 15 July 1959 - 15 February 2019 Office for Security and Counter Terrorism (Home Office) Chairman, Jt Intelligence Committee. One time U K Defence Forum speaker

FIELD Maj Gen Geoffrey William Field CB, CVO, OBE 30 November 1941 - 1 February 2019

Royal Engineers. Falklands. Later Engineer-in-chief and Governor of the Tower of London

GREEN Brig Duncan Ross Green CBE MC died 21st April 2019 aged 93 10th Gurkha Rifles

GREENHILL Air Cdre John Granger Greenhill died 6 June 2019

GRANT Capt Neil Anthony Douglas Grant RN CBE died 20 April 2019 aged 82

LEDSOM Robert Kenneth Ledsom RN died 5 April 2019

MACFARLANE Maj General William Thompson (Bill) Macfarlane CB died 14 April 2019 aged 93

MANGLES Major Robert Miller Mangles RE died 18 June 2019 aged 88

MORTON Rev Mark Morton 22 July 1958 - 2019 Army chaplain Northern Ireland, Kosovo, Bosnia

Indian Army 7th Rajput Regt Burma. Later diplomat

O'KELLY Captain EMS (Mike) Kelly RN died 13 April 2019

PRATT Dr David Lynn Pratt CBE 16 August 1924 - 13 Marh 2019

Royal Engineer "Hobart's Funnies" Juno beach D-Day . Eventually commanding PoW camp.

PRICE AVM John Price CBE died 26 April 2019 aged 89

ROBINS Lt Col Walter Robins OBE died 3 April 2019 aged 89. Duke of Wellington's Regt

SANFORD Bevis Sanford 15 March 1918 - 4 April 2019 King's African Rifles Ethiopia and Abyssinia, Later Colonial Serv

SAUVAGE Sqn Ldr Joseph Henri Jean (John) Sauvage OBE, DSO, DFC & Bar 9 February 1919 - 2 April 2019

64 opns with Bomber Command then Transport Command 44 Sqn Hampdens; 100 bomber raids twice; 97 Sqn Pathfinders Lancasters; later D Day Deception "Monty's double) and VIP flight India

SEABROOK Col Peter William George Seabrook died 3 April 2019 aged 91 Royal Artillery

SUTCLIFFE Brigadier Maurice William Sutcliffe OBE MiD10 October 1922 - 8 April 2019

Wounded with Royal Irish Fusiliers North Africa Op Torch. Army liaison with RAF, flew 12 missions over Europe. SOE parachuted into Croatia to support Resistance. RN helicopters liaison Malaya. After pilot qualification joined newly founded Army Air Corps. Germany. Cdr aviation Army Strategic Command

TADMAN Col John Tadman died 12 March 2019 aged 85 Royal Anglian Regt

THORNELOE Major John Thorneloe RA died 4 April 2019 aged 96

WALKER Surgeon Vice Adm Alasdair James WalkerCB OBE 22 June 1956 - 1 June 2019 finally surgeon general of the armed forces. HMS Plymouth Falklands - first British warship to enter Port Stanley. Supported Royal Marines Iraq War (Kuwait) Kosovo, Bosnia, Sierra Leone,
