CARINE Rear Adm James Carine died 27 Feb 24 aged 89

CARTLEDGE Christopher Reginald Cartledge DSC 1942 Fleet Air Arm died 21 Jan 2024 aged 100. 1842 SQn 1944 Attacked Tirpitz from HMS Formidable (Corsairs), 1945 kamikaze attack Pacific. Plane hit, ditched in ocean.

CULLENS Lt Col David Kernoham Cullens died 22 Jan 24 RAEC

HELY HUTCHINSON Lt Cdr Christopher Hely Hutchinson died 11 Jan 24 aged 92

JENNINGS Private Jack Jennings 10 March 1923 - 19 January 2024. 1st Bn Cambridgeshire Regt, Defence of Singapore February 1942. Shipped to Thailand. In 1945 dug mass graves for prisoners. Believed one of last survivors of Burma Death Railway. Later author Prisoner without a crime.

KITSON General Sir Frank Edward Kitson GBE, KCB, MC and Bar, CBE (for gallantry) 15 Dec 1926 - 2 Jan 24 Rifle Brigade Kenya, Malaysia; Cyprus - Cdr 1st Bn Royal Green Jackets Cdr 39th Infantry Brigade N Ireland; Cyprus; Cdr 2nd Armoured Divn Germany; Cdt Staff College; C in C UK Land Forces. Military author inc Low Intensity Operations

LACHLAN Major Edward (Ted) Lachlan RA die 11th Feb 24 aged 93

PRENTIS Cdr Christopher David Prentis DSC RN died 19 Feb 2024 aged 91

RORKE Patricia Rorke (later Johnston) 28 October 1923- 9 December 23 WAAC, junior intelligence officer Special Liaison Unit Delhi (with Bletchley Park) Also listing names of British dead or wounded

SADLER Major (Willis) Michael Sadler MC, MM Legion d'Honneur 22 Feb 1920 - 4 Jan 23. Last survivor of Long Range Desert Group and original SAS member. According to a personal obituary published on LinkedIn: "Sadler was unique, an expert navigator whose skill and temperament formed the bond between L Detachment SAS and the LRDG. Without him the

SAS would have struggled to survive during their early days. He was able to put them on top of airfields in N Africa, hundreds, sometimes thousands of miles beyond enemy lines, in the dark and dead of night."Tamet and Sidi Haneishi raids (MM) Invasion of Sicily and Italy. In 1942 as a Sgt he joined the SAS, commissioned in the field (although Stirling never completed the paperwork, causing Sadler to be arrested for impersonating an officer) and joined the intelligence section for the invasion of France. STEPHENS Lt Cdr Philip George Stephens died 13 Feb 24 aged 97

STEWART Sir (James) Moray Stewart KCB died 30 Dec 23 aged 85. Former 2nd PUS, MoD. Later Vice President, Eurodefense UK

TRAHAN Nicola (Nicole) Pauline MarieTrahan MBE Croix de Guere (with palms) Medaille de la Reconnaissance Francaise SOE courier codename "Teddy" 21 December 1926 - 18 Jan 24 Began parachute training aged 16. Late 43 landed by Lysander nr Valencay ("Wrestler" area). Extracted in time for 17th birthday. Parachuted into France 3 times. Post D Day sabotage and offensive actions Later SSAFA health visitor Germany, Belgium, Hong Kong In 2017 awarded "wings" by SAS

TRISTRAM EVE Colonel Peter Tristram Eve died 30 Dec 23 aged 93 Royal Green Jackets

TYLER Lt Cdr Alan Tyler 2 April 1934 - 16 Oct 23 HMS Ajax navigating officer's assistant aged 17 - bombarding Libyan border. HMS Hasty Malta, Mediterranean convoys escort. HMS Revenge Eastern Fleet (midshipman) MTBs North Sea. HMS Chevron Med, Palestine. HMS Plym destroyed at Monte Bello first UK atomic test (Op Hurricane) HMS Birmingham Far East. Admiralty Russian section Naval Intelligence

VICKERS Lt General Sir Richard Maurice Hilton Vickers KCB, CVE, OBE 21 August 1928 - 6 Feb 2023 Royal Tank Regt Sword of Honour, King's Medal at Sandhurst Korean War. Adjutant 2RTR BAOR. ADC to HM Queen. CoS 8th Armoured Brigade. 4RTR Borneo. C/O newly formed Blues and Royals c/o 11 Armoured Brigade c/o 4th Armoured Divn, Commandant Sandhurst. DG Army Training.Late DG Winston Churchill Memorial Trust. Gentlem Usher to HMQ 86-98

WAUGHMAN Flt Lt Russell "Rusty" Reay Waughman DFC, AFC, Legion d'Honneur MiD 19 Jan 1923 - Dec 14 2023 101 (Special Duties) Sqn. Lancasters electronic counter measures Ruhr, Berlin, Nuremburg (RAF's worst night) 30 missions Sqn lost 1176 men in war. Later instructor-examiner Transport Command. Berlin airlift
